



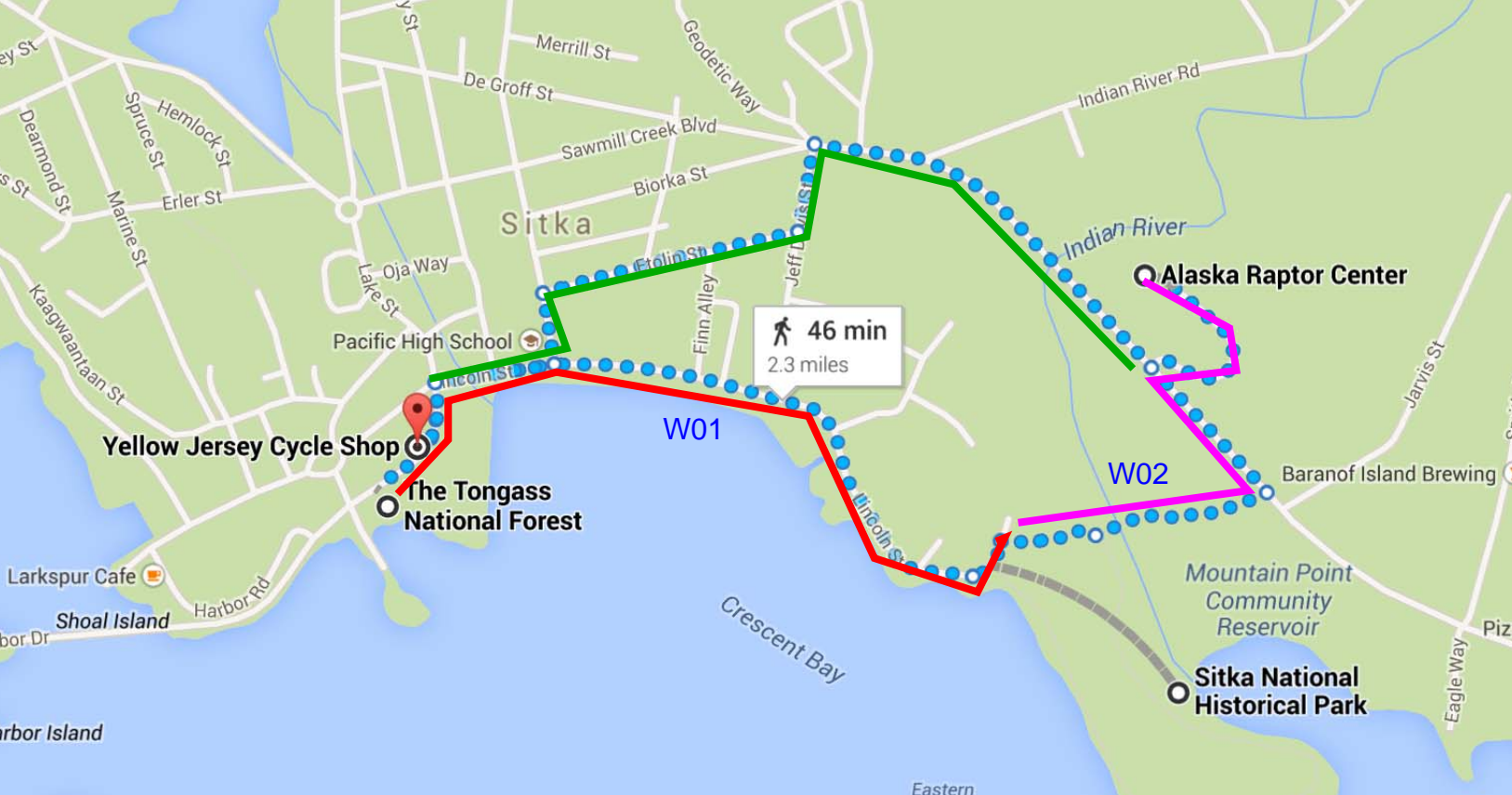
FHWA Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Assessment

1:45-2:45	Complete bicycle assessment B02 (weather permitting)	Lincoln Street to round-a-bout and out Halibut Point Road to Pioneer Park (SeaMart) and return to Cen. Hall on opposite side of road.
3:00 – 4:00	Discussion at Centennial Hall	Collect assessments, current and future projects in Sitka. Federal Aid opportunities.
